

Shane Ozbirn Named Alpine Firefighter of the Year

Shane Ozbirn was born and raised in Alpine. He attended **Shadow Hills Elementary School**, **Joan McQueen Middle School**, and **Steele Canyon High School**. His father was a U.S. Border Patrol Agent, and his mother was heavily involved in our community.

When Shane was in the first grade, The **Alpine Fire Protection District (AFPD)** brought the fire engine to his school for a demonstration. He decided at that moment that he wanted to be a firefighter when he grew up. Specifically, he wanted to be a firefighter in Alpine.

At just 15 years old, he started as an explorer with the **Viejas Fire Department**; volunteering every day after school, and on the weekends. During this time, he received an award from the **Boy Scouts of America** recognizing him for his volunteer service. At 18 years old, **Shane** started as a Reserve Firefighter for the **San Miguel Fire Protection District**. During that time, **Shane** had the opportunity to attend the **Heartland Fire Academy**. At age 18, **Shane** was the youngest recruit to complete this intense 5-month academy. He graduated with distinction.

Shane did not rest after completion of the Fire Academy. He immediately began working towards the difficult task of becoming a Paramedic. He attended Paramedic school in El Cajon, did his clinical internship at **Grossmont Hospital**, and his field internship with **Heartland Fire and Rescue** in El Cajon. The whole process took over a year of full-time, unpaid work. Shortly after earning his Paramedic License, Shane was offered his first full-time, paid Firefighter job with the **Viejas Fire Department**.

Then, at just 22 years old, **Shane** was chosen from a large group of highly qualified candidates for a Firefighter Paramedic position here in **Alpine**. He was, and still is, the youngest Firefighter in the

wonderful Post members who have supported our Post vision and mission. It is possible I may be the longest running Quartermaster in the state. Thanks for your support and complete trust as we "Protect the Post" both for the present and build a solid future for years to come.

I am always available 24/7 to handle any issues that affect you or our great Post.

From the bottom of my heart, I wish each one of you a personal transformative ending to 2019 and rebirth in 2020! Blessings and Peace!




