Courtesy; manners; respectfulness. These should be more than just words when referring to the behavior of members and guests at our

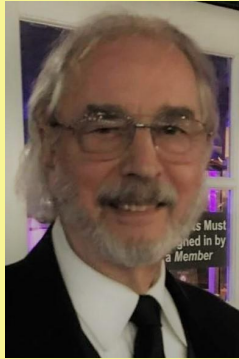


