

House Committee Report

Comrades:

I hope everyone is well. August was a pretty good month for



Purple Heart veterans receive one free drink per day. If you received a Purple Heart or are a Korean War Veteran, please bring in a copy of your DD-214 so we can add you to the distribution list.

We passed inspection on the concrete swale located along the top of the brick wall downstairs; and we filled in the cracks between the rocks to help prevent failure of the wall in the future. Project cost: \$3,600.

We are still waiting on the contractor to start the deck extension in the old BBQ area. We are working on plans for the access ramp.

We are now getting bids on the parking lot area to pave the area from which we removed the rocks and to also coat the rest of the parking area. This will include several more handicap parking spots and striping.

We are still working on receiving bids for the new security system to replace our current system which is outdated with failing cameras. We have one bid for \$20,000 which will cover all the blinds spots with overlapping coverage and features a 30-day storage and 30-minute battery back up.

Some of our members (and guests) have been using foul language when in the **Post Canteen**. We all need to keep ourselves and others in check if foul language is used.


Auxiliary President's Message
