


Commander's Message



was born in

Johnstown Pa. After graduating from Chesapeake High School in 1980 and enlisted in the **US Navy** on 02 October 1980.

He served in numerous Commands throughout his 30 year career most of them at Construction Battalion Center, Port Hueneme, CA. He deployed 17 times during his career with two tours in Iraq, one In Afghanistan, and his last deployment to the Horn of Africa.

Master Chief Yingling's personnel awards include the Purple Heart medal, two Meritorious Service medals, three Navy Commendation medals, Army Commendation medal, Navy Achievement medal, Combat Action ribbon with Gold Star, seven Good Conduct medals, Presidential Unit Citation, Antarctic Service medal, Afghanistan Campaign Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary medal, ISAF Medal, Expert Rifle & Pistol Medals

My trip to WV to celebrate my Mom's 97 th birthday was filled with family, love, happiness, good times, great food, and now - fond memories.

There's always a feeling of emptiness when you are the person being "left" after a visit. I had to drive to the airport and then fly back across the US; I was sad but busy – my Mom, on the other hand, stood in her doorway, softly crying...it's hard to be the one left behind.

My second son and daughter-in-law who live in **Santiago**, **Chile** were finally able to visit the USA after COVID-19 restrictions were lifted. It has been four years and four months since we have seen them. Such excitement! They were here for three days and just left this morning for two weeks in Hawaii...it's hard to be the one left behind.

They will be back for about 10 days and then they will go back home... but this time, barring all unforeseen pandemics and plagues, they will be back in June 2023 for the wedding of my daughter **Anna**. This time it won't be... as hard to be the one left behind.

But, by far, the hardest time to be the one left... is when it is final.

This morning we received the very sad news that our dear friend and VFW Life Member Bill Shepherd had passed. He fought a heroic battle with lung cancer (as a victim of Agent Orange from his time in the Vietnam War). Up until the end he gave it his all. He kept his sense of humor, humility, and sweet mischievous smile long after others would have given in to the pain and struggle. He finally passed peacefully.

Please keep **Bill**'s precious love **Jeanne** in your prayers and hearts. Our dear friend and **Auxiliary Life Member Jeanne Pate** will need us to surround her with love at this time. Let her know how much she and **Bill** mean to you by not letting her feel like... the one left behind.

We are now returning Bill to you, the God of Love, who lent him to us for his time on this Earth. 





You have received a phone call, pe or laptop screen pop-up or email informing you that there is a problem with your computer or laptop: Pretending to be from a popular tech company, scammers will try to convince you that your computer or laptop is infected and they want to immediately remote in to it, and then will gain access to your personal and financial information...


