

#### **Veterans Day**

Veterans Day (originally known as Armistice Day) is a federal holiday in the United States observed annually on November 11, for honoring military veterans, who are people who have served in the United States Armed Forces (that were discharged under conditions other than dishonorable).

It coincides with other holidays including **Armistice Day** and **Remembrance Day** which are celebrated in other countries that mark the anniversary of the end of **World War I**. Major hostilities of **World War I** were formally ended at the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month of 1918 when the **Armistice with Germany** went into effect.

At the urging of major U.S. veteran organizations, **Armistice Day** was renamed **Veterans Day** in 1954. **Veterans Day** is distinct from **Memorial Day**, a U.S. public holiday in May.



Auxiliary Chaplain's position here at our VFW Post 9578 is going to a Celebration of Life or attending the interment services for a Post or Auxiliary member. Since I lost my son in 2017, I have been more and more certain of my path in this life. I have come to cherish my Auxiliary Chaplain's position and what I am able to offer to others.

In October, my husband **Post Chaplain Theo** and I went to three services. Sharing grief with friends and their families has been a gift that we can give to others, we are honored to help. We are entrusted with their deep feelings, thoughts, and concerns in a time of true need.

Grief needs an outlet. I have come to realize that not everyone has a "person" they can talk to, share with, or just unload on.

Grieving is very isolating. Some people never get over losing their loved one. They live a life of loneliness. This should not be happening. Often, I have found we do not take time to just listen to others who need a shoulder to cry on. We have to remember their loved ones. Mention their name out loud. Ask a grieving person: "What did you love most about them?" "Tell me a story about them." I really believe this will help ease the pain a little and reassure the person that someone cares; for their loved one and them.
