Quartermaster's Message

Since I've been in the **Quartermaster** position for about six months now, I thought it would be important for members to know what the position



entails. Therefore, from the VFW Quartermaster's Guide (2019 - 2020): "The Post Quartermaster is the chief financial officer of the Post. The Quartermaster is the custodian of all Post property and the officer responsible for safeguarding Post funds and property. The Quartermaster is accountable to the Post, Department and the National Organization for all the monies, securities, vouchers and property of the Post. The Quartermaster is the only one authorized under the Bylaws, to receive, handle, and account for funds of the Post. As Quartermaster, you may authorize a person to disburse funds on your behalf; however, they must be bonded. There are no exceptions to this rule!

No committee, holding company, canteen manager, group or individual in the **Post** or in any way connected with the **Post**'s activities, can take this authority and responsibility from the **Post Quartermaster**.

All funds, monies or property accumulated under the name of the Veterans of Foreign Wars for the **Post**, regardless of the nature of the activity which accumulates them, are the property of the **Post** and are subject only to disposition by **Post** action. here at the **Post**. I love that we have volunteers that do what they do without wanting recognition or certificates! They just do it because they love this **Post** and its members! I love that people volunteer here and don't post about it and don't tell us everything they do because they genuinely just want to serve!

Post leadership is just that! You help lead the members and future members. If you are in leadership and you are the first one to leave the **Post** or you are only around for the meetings because you have to be here maybe its not the position for you.



is finally here! I hope this December message finds you with that feeling of joy, warmth and nostalgia that people feel when they hear **Christmas** carols and the jingle bells start jingling.

In the 1840s, marketers began to see **Christmas**



Alabama was the first state to officially recognize **Christmas** in 1836.

However, the birth date of **Jesus** is still a mystery. The date of birth of **Jesus** is not stated in the gospels or in any historical sources. Most biblical scholars generally accept a date of birth between 6 BC and 4 BC, the year in which **King Herod** died.

Today's scholars believe that the main reason **Jesus**' birth came to be celebrated on **December 25**th is because that was the date of the **Winter Solstice** according to the Roman calendar.

Historians may not consider the **Bible** a complete historical document, but rather a supportive document used in concert with other, more accurate historical documents

So, why was **December 25** chosen as the birthday of **Jesus**?

The reason for the selection of Dec. 25 seems to have been that it is exactly nine months after **March 25**, the traditionally acknowledged date of **Jesus'** crucifixion. As Christians developed the theological idea that **Jesus** was conceived and crucified on the same date, they set the date of his birth nine months later.

Finally, The **New Testament** gives no information about what time of year **Jesus** was born.

What we really know for sure, **Jesus** was a Jew. He was born of a Jewish mother in **Galilee**, a Jewish part of the world. All of his friends, associates, colleagues, disciples were **Jews**. 
