Dear Comrades,
Sisters, and Brothers:

Spring – a time for
change – and a time to
reflect. Have you lost
your faith?

My Mom Virginia, who lives in West Virginia, turned 99.5 in March. As far as we all knew, she was doing as well as a 99.5 year-old could be doing. Still living on her own and happy that my brother was visiting her for the weekend. Enjoying her adoptive holiday of **St. Patrick's Day** on the 17th. She is Polish, but our Dad was Irish. That evening, she was courageously fighting for her life. We didn't know at the time, but she was extremely sick. She was taken by ambulance to the emergency room. No matter what they tried – she kept getting worse. The last rites were administered to her in the early morning of March 18. Her six children and several grandchildren took turns calling and saying our goodbyes over the phone – and then we all waited... and waited. Our two sisters gave hour by hour reports of what was going on. We all prayed – nonstop.

Finally, after almost 10 days of testing and changing tactics - we have our Mom back! A true miracle of the Last Rites? We all believe! We have always thought our Mom was amazing, but this really nailed it! She is extremely excited and determined to see


